This map was prepared by the Windham Regional Commission using GIS (Geographic Information System) technology. It is intended to be used for general planning and reference purposes. While every effort has been made to insure that the data for the Town of Putney are current, complete, and accurate, the data for adjacent towns are not of this quality. - Data sources for the Town of Putney:
- Town highway locations were digitized from 1989 1:5000 orthophotos by Greenhome & O'Mara Inc. under contract with OGIS. Some road locations were updated by microDATA using GPS during data collection for Enhanced 9-1-1 in 1997.
 - Town highway attributes (i.e. class and pavement) are from AOT highway maps. These data were corrected by WRC GIS staff in 2000 using information provided by officials from the Town of Putney.
 - Road names data were provided by the Town of Putney and are current to 2000.
 - Surface waters were digitized 1974 1:20,000 orthophotos by the University of Vermont's School of Natural Resources under contract with OGIS.
 - Electric transmission lines were digitized from 1:5000 orthophotos by Greenhome & O'Mara Inc. under contract with OGIS.
 - Boundaries for most town-owned lands were located by William FitzGerald, Land Surveyor, Putney, Vt. and were captured by WRC GIS staff using a GPS receiver. Some boundaries, however, were taken from Town of Putney 1:5000 parcel maps.
 - Boundaries of other public and conservation lands are from William FitzGerald, Land Surveyor, Putney, Vt.; WRC GIS staff GPS mapping; Town of Putney 1:5000 parcel maps; or U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service survey data.
 - Building locations were captured using Global Positioning System technology by microDATA, St. Johnsbury, VT for Vermont's Enhanced 9-1-1 program. These data have been checked by Putney's 99-1-1 coordinator and are current to 1997.
 - Contour lines were generated from USGS 1:24,000 Digital Elevation Models by VCGI and edited by WRC. They are intended to portray the general hypsography of the area and should not be used to determine actual elevations.
- Data sources for other towns:
- Data for the Towns of Dummerston, Brookline, and Westminster are from various existing WRC and VCGI data. In many cases these data have not been checked for accuracy.
