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Parcel use:

size of parcel - small → large
intensity of use - high → low

- * farms
- public services/cultural
- industrial/utility
- commercial
- residential
- vacant residential
- commercial (low density/large parcel)
- rural (very low density residential)
- undeveloped land

Parcel status:

- Active agriculture or forestry management plan * (parcel enrolled in Use Value Appraisal, 2010)
- Development restriction, private land with conservation easement **
- Conservation non-profit ownership
- Public land managed for recreation, conservation, and/or open space

* - not all active ag. or forestry parcels mapped
** - not all parcels with other development restrictions mapped

* farms are parcels dominated by actively-used agricultural land other than sugarbushes, hayfields, and pasturelands

Data source:
- Parcel land use was developed in 2011 by referring to the land use codes in the Putney Grand List, E911 buildings data edited by Cartographic Technologies, orthophotos, and data from the Putney Planning Commission and Windham Regional Commission. Land use codes are meant to provide information on the dominant use of a parcel.
